With this in view, this HEI has laid emphasis on zero tolerance of any kind of indiscipline.

4. The Practice

- **Code of Conduct:** This College has a comprehensive code of conduct, which all students are required to follow. This includes guidelines on attendance, behaviour, use of college facilities and adherence to academic integrity.
- **Orientation Programs:** In the beginning of each academic year, orientation sessions for students are organized to teach them the importance of discipline, punctuality, and academic honesty as well as the adverse and harmful consequences of indiscipline.
- **Academic and Behavioural Monitoring:** Attendance is strictly monitored, and students with poor attendance are given warnings and counselling.
- **24 hour Squading:** For discipline in the campus and better academic environment squad teams have been formed. Team members are moving around the academic building for proper

engagement of classes and to check the indiscipline. Further Superintendents of Hostels and other staff are assigned to maintain discipline in the residential campus.

5. Evidence of Success

Surveys and feedback from students highlight the positive impact of the discipline shaping initiatives on their overall growth and learning.

- **Improved Academic Performance:** Data shows that students who adhere to the discipline guidelines tend to perform better academically.
- **Zero occurrence of Indiscipline:** The number of disciplinary violations has decreased significantly over the years, indicating the success of the initiative.


6. Problems/Challenges Encountered and Resources Required

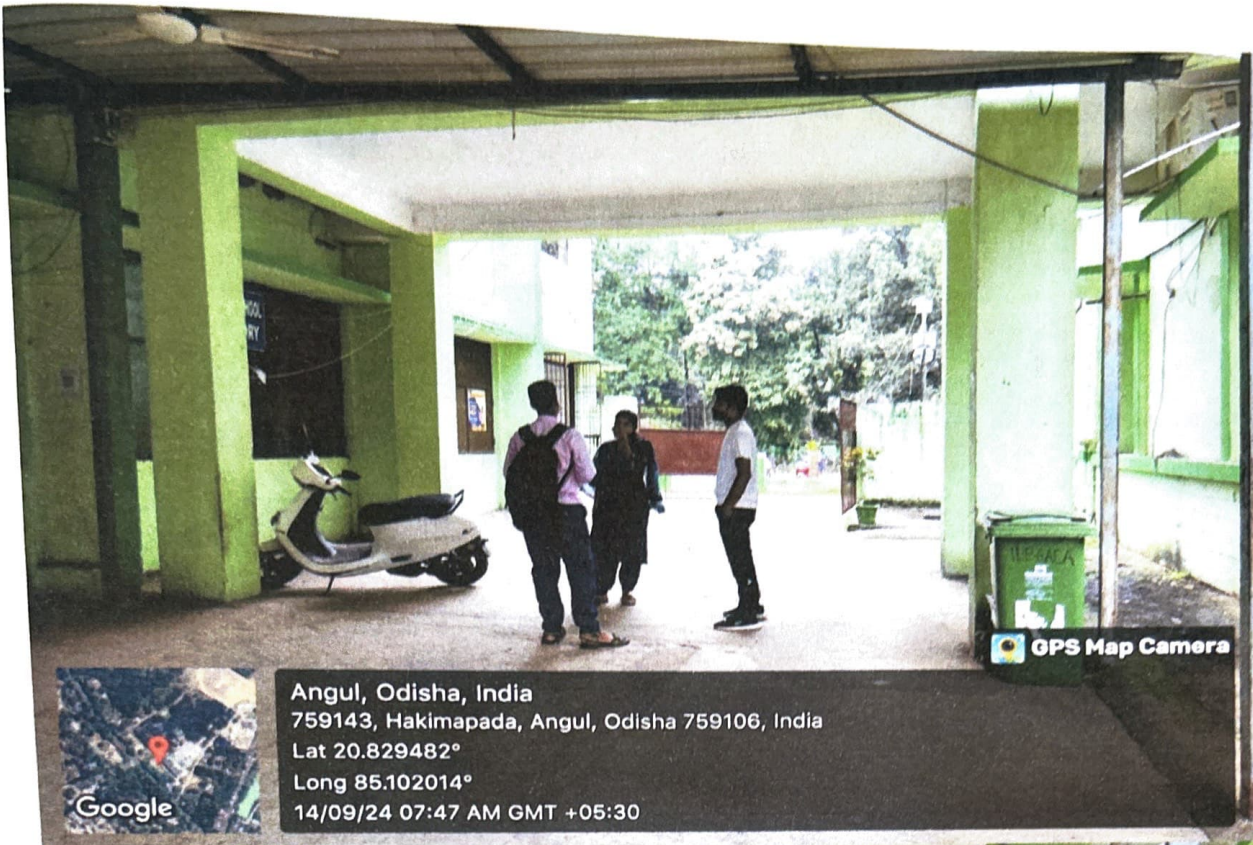

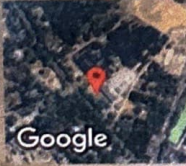
