ADMISSION POLICY

Government Autonomous College, Angul is a premiere institute of Higher Education in the state of odisha providing UG and PG teaching facilities to about 4000 students through its 20 UG and 20 PG departments.

In order to make the admission process transparent, hassle free, time-oriented and user-friendly, the Govt. of odisha in the Higher Education department have introduced Students Academic Management System (SAMS). Students can apply for admission to various courses at various institutes across the state through online mode. Before commencement of the process extensive advertisements are published by the Higher Education Department, Govt. of Odisha in important Daily Newspapers. Besides, the advertisement is also made available on the SAMS portal itself. In this system parents or their wards do not require to move from college to college to apply for the college of their choice rather they visit the college physically only once to get admission into the stream in which they have been selected. Even the admission and readmission fees are collected in online mode only. This facility also helps the colleges to carry out this apparently cumbersome process in very smooth, fair, impartial and transparent manner.

A: e-Admission Procedure

1. Application Submission Process

UG -The CAF (Common Application Form) is made available at <https://degree.samsodisha.gov.in/DegreeNew/index.aspx> for applying online only. There is one Common Application Form (CAF) for admission to any stream of any HEI in the State including this college. Students normally apply the CAF online at Home, Cybercafe, Common Service Centres, Internet Facility Centre available in HEIs (if available), etc.



PG - Candidates are selected from CPET (Common PG Entrance Test) for PG Admission. The CAF is made available at <https://pg.samsodisha.gov.in/> for applying online only.

2. Common Application Form Fees

UG- Applicants exercise options in the CAF for the academic session. A student is allowed to exercise minimum 5 options and maximum unlimited options in choice of streams, subjects and colleges. Option wise fees are not collected. Rather General applicants pay Rs. 275/- per application and SC/ST applicants pay Rs. 175/- per application irrespective of the number of choices. Further no fee is charged from PWD and Transgender applicants. **(CAF Fees are deposited in online mode in the SAMS portal only).**

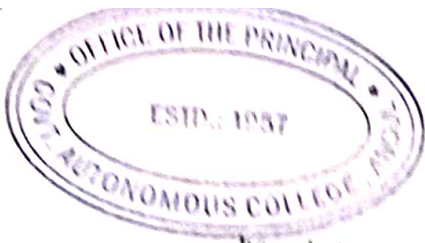
PG - The CAF fees in case of appearing multiple entrance subjects will be as follows:

- First or only subject: ₹. 500/- for General category Candidates and ₹. 300 for SC/ST category candidates.
- For every additional entrance subject: ₹. 200/- for both General and SC/ST Category candidates.
- The CAF fees will not be collected from the applicants who belong to PwD Category, Transgender, orphan, Child without Biological Parents & the applicants staying at Child Care Institutions.
- A candidate can apply to appear at the entrance examination in maximum Subjects. He/she is also required to provide preferences for the Universities or Colleges of his/her choice. The Subject + HEI (University/Colleges) combination will define his/her option.
- A student can exercise the option of choice up to 20 colleges.

3. Principles of Selection

a. Eligibility

UG- An applicant must have passed Higher Secondary (+2) Examination under the Council of Higher Secondary Education, Odisha or equivalent



boards/councils to become eligible for applying admission into degree courses.

PG-The subject wise minimum eligibility for the CPET-2024 is available in the SAMS website. Please click on the link(<https://pr.samsodisha.gov.in/Eligibility.aspx>) to get the list.

b. Reservation

i. Scheduled Caste [SC] & Scheduled Tribe [ST]

- a) SC-16.25% of the sanctioned strength of each programme shall be reserved for SC applicants [G.O. 11710/HE, Dtd.: 01/06/2015].
- b) ST-22.5% of the sanctioned strength of each programme shall be reserved for ST applicants [G.O. 11710/HE, Dtd.: 01/06/2015].
- c) The reserved seats are not interchangeable between SC & ST.
- d) SC/ST applicants selected for admission on their merit shall not be counted against reserved seats.

However, any modification made by the Government in the reservation policy will be followed during admission.

ii. Persons with Disability (PwD)

5% of sanctioned seats shall be reserved for PwD students with the extent of disability not below 40% (Blind and Low Vision, Hard of Hearing, Locomotors Disability including Cerebral Palsy, Leprosy Cured, Dwarfism, Acid Attack Victims and Muscular Dystrophy, Autism, Intellectual Disability, Specific Learning Disability, and Mental Illness). [G.O. 10161/HE, Dtd.: 07/04/2018].

iii. Ex-Serviceman [ESM], Serving Defencepersonnel [SDP], Children of Martyrs [CoM]

1% of the sanctioned seats shall be reserved for Self/ Children/ Wife/ Husband/ of Ex-Serviceman, Serving Defense Personnel and Children of Martyrs.

C. Weightage



Number of seats in each stream, filled up by the applicants with weightage, shall not exceed 10% of the sanctioned strength. This 10% of seats shall be proportionately distributed among all categories of applicants. An applicant, who is selected with weightage and taken admission, shall continue to remain in this 10% bracket, even if the cut-off mark is reduced in subsequent selections. A maximum 10% weightage mark shall be provided to an applicant.

a. NCC

Applicants holding "B" Certificate only, shall be given weightage of an additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2) or Equivalent examination.

Applicants holding "A" & "C" Certificates shall not be given any weightage to admission into U.G. (Degree/+3) Courses.

Applicants who have represented the State or the Central School/Sainik School at the All-India level NCC Camps / Courses / Activities shall be given weightage of an additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2) or Equivalent examination.

b. NSS

a. Applicants who have represented the Country at the International level shall be given direct admission.

b. Applicants who have represented the state and National Level Camp shall be given a Weightage of an additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the CHSE/Equivalent examination.

c. Applicants who have represented the Inter-State Category Camp shall be given a Weightage of an additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the CHSE/Equivalent examination.

d. Applicants who have got the best NSS Volunteer award at Council/ Board level shall be given a Weightage of an additional 2% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured in the CHSE/Equivalent examination.

c. Rover & Ranger



a. Rover & Ranger possessing and producing the original certificate signed by the President of India shall be given weightage of an additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2)/Equivalent examination.

b. Rover & Ranger possessing and producing the original certificate signed by the Governor/ PATRON/ President of the State Association shall be given weightage of an additional 2% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2)/Equivalent examination.

d. Sports & Games

a. Applicants who have represented the country at the International level and have a weightage Certificate issued by Sports Department shall be allotted to his/her 1st Preference.

b. Applicants who have represented the state at the national level shall be given weightage of an additional 10% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the Higher Secondary (+2)/Equivalent examination.

B: Admission Procedure

Selection for admission is done by SAMS, Odisha except for the waiting list admission. However for waiting list admission SAMS provides a waiting list normally 5 times of the vacancies existing then. Out of the provided list by SAMS, our institution prepares a merit list basing upon vacancies and carries out the admission process. Selected applicants have to produce the Intimation Letter before the admission committee at the Destination HEI on the date and time as declared by the Higher Education Department. Applicant has to produce all original documents for verification only at this college during admission.. No original documents are to be deposited with the college authority.

C: Admission fees

The admission fees for admission into U.G. and P.G. courses are collected online from students through SAMS Portal during the e-Admission period, within the timeline set by Department of Higher Education.



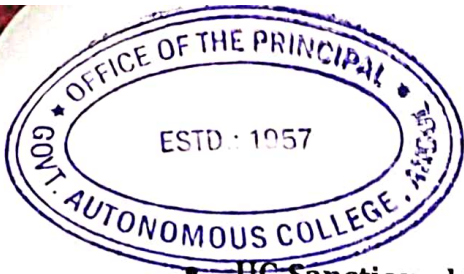
