1. Introduction

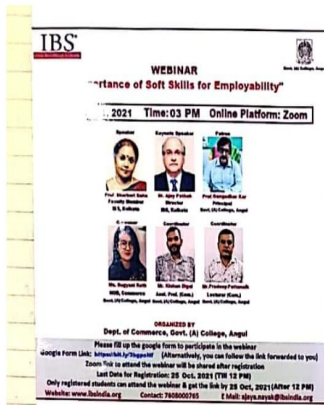

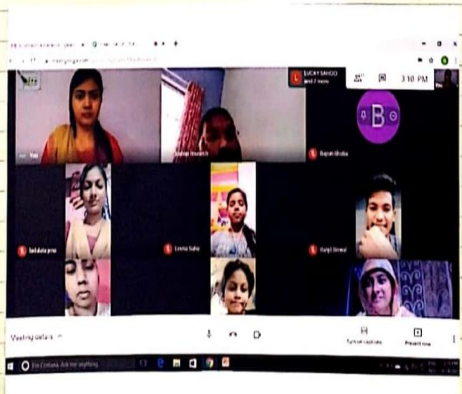
Few students presented their paper on this topic using power point presentation (PPT).
